

Lots has happened since our last newsletter: Ascension Day, Pentecost, Trinity Sunday, and the English District convention, and now we're into summer with the apostle Paul's words to the Galatians ringing in our ears: "the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law" (Galatians 5:22-23). As our Garden State peach trees ripen and bear their delicious fruit in these halcyon days of summer, I look forward to the Holy Spirit ripening and bearing its fruit in the life of our congregation.

At the LCMS English District convention (June 20-22 in Ann Arbor, Michigan), Herb Gishlick and I represented Messiah. A number of significant resolutions were passed, and I will forward you a link to the convention minutes when I receive them. Also at the convention, our New York circuit of nine congregations between Scarsdale, NY, and Pennsauken, NJ, selected and received a new circuit visitor: the Rev. Gordon Naumann of Trinity Lutheran Church in Scarsdale, NY. I appreciate Pastor Naumann taking on this leadership role following my seven years in the position, and pray that God will bless him and our circuit in his new role.

At Messiah, 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary building improvement projects have moved into high gear, with the dead pin oak tree in the back yard having been cut down in May and the kitchen cabinets emptied (thank you, Debbie Baer and Pat Hlafter) on June 29 to prepare for the renovation of the kitchen (planned for late July and early August). Nelson Glass is scheduled to install our new fellowship hall windows June 30-July 1 and July 7-8.

To celebrate Messiah's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary, the March 27 voters meeting decided to set up a 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Fund, donations to which will go toward anniversary events and building improvement projects. Fund contributions and anniversary project expenses will be reported in the Sunday bulletins and updated monthly. Donations to the fund are welcome and encouraging, and should be over and above pledged and regular giving.

Spring and summer are bittersweet seasons at Messiah, as we say goodbye to beloved friends and welcome new ones. Among those leaving us are Mitchell Stroebel, who graduated from Princeton University in May, and the Boedecker family, moving to the Midwest where Ben has a job following his retirement from the US Air Force. We are sorry to see them go and wish them God's blessings in their homes and endeavors.

## 75TH ANNIVERSARY FUND

At the March 27 Voters' Meeting, it was suggested that a fundraising campaign in honor of Messiah's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary be instituted. The intent is to raise funds, over and above pledged and regular giving, to support Messiah's 75<sup>th</sup> anniversary activities and projects, helping to defray the cost of upcoming building upgrades and renovations, as well as special anniversary events. Given the number of projects involved and the complexity of managing gifts restricted to each one, we ask that contributions in support of these projects be made to the anniversary effort as a whole. \* To this end, a separate 75<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Fund is being created.

There are many exciting plans for this anniversary year. A number of building and grounds improvement projects are slated. The sanctuary and other areas have already been freshly painted. The windows in the fellowship hall and kitchen are currently being replaced. The kitchen will also get new counters, cabinets, and appliances later this summer. In addition, the kitchen layout will be reconfigured to improve efficiency and traffic flow. Outside the church building, trees have been removed and replanted, and re-grading is planned in the back yard to direct water flow away from the building.

The anniversary celebration officially began on April 3, when Pastor Goerss preached the sermon and later reminisced at the special fellowship hour about his nearly quarter of a century as Messiah's pastor. In November, the acclaimed organ soloist, Eric Plutz, the University Organist at Princeton University, will present a concert at Messiah as part of the celebration. Festivities will conclude in June 2023 with a gala luncheon.

We invite everyone – the congregation, former members, and friends of Messiah – to celebrate with us and participate by making a donation to the  $75^{th}$  Anniversary Fund.

\*If contributions exceed the cost of anniversary projects, the balance will be considered unrestricted.
